# VOLUNTEER DRIVER PROGRAM



## What is the Volunteer Driver Program?

The Volunteer Driver Program is designed for those who have no other supports in the community - such as family or friends - to assist them to their specialist related healthcare medical appointments in Edmonton and neighbouring communities.

The Program provides transportation for healthcare appointments within a one-way 200 kilometre distance.

Volunteer Drivers provide a safe, free and reliable curb to curb transportation for residents who would otherwise struggle to meet this need.

Clients must be physically able to transport themselves in and out of a vehicle, and can bring a companion to assist them if needed.

## How do I Access the Program?

All drive requests are managed by the Town of Whitecourt's Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) Program Coordinator. Contact the FCSS Program Coordinator to discuss your needs and learn more about the program .

Please give as much notice as possible when requesting transportation. We aim for two weeks' notice to arrange rides from our pool of drivers.
